



Global Strategic Development Task Force

- GSDTF developed the AIA Strategy for Global Engagement report to help ensure that globally practicing AIA members (and their professional practice needs) are integrated into all AIA programs.






Revenue 2020



Officer Terms

7.2.(a & b)

(a) The President, who shall serve in that capacity for two (2) years.

In the President's first year, the Immediate Past President's office will be filled and the First Vice President's office will be vacant. In the President's second year, the Immediate Past President's office will be vacant, and the First Vice President's office will be filled.

In the event the President is unable or unwilling to serve, the First Vice President shall assume the office of President; if the First Vice President office is vacant, then Immediate Past President shall assume the office of the President.

(b) The First Vice President, who shall serve in that capacity for one (1) year, and shall succeed to the Presidency upon completion of such term as First Vice President. Upon succession to the Presidency, the office of the First Vice President will remain vacant for one year.

Summary of change:

Shortens the overall duration of time commitment to volunteer for the procession from First Vice President to President to Immediate Past President



Bylaws updates

Removal of Zone Director Language

The out-dated language referring to zone directors has been sanitised throughout.

Strategic Council Representative Selection

7.2.(h)

The AIA International representative(s) to the AIA's Strategic Council, who shall serve as an ex officio member of the Board for the duration of the member's service on the Strategic Council. This representative shall be selected in a manner to be determined by the Board.

Summary of change: The previous cycle of rotating the position between the chapters pre-dated the formation of the International Region. The current number of chapters results in a rotation period of 21 years.

Adjunct Directors

7.2. (i)

At the discretion of the Board, an Adjunct Director may be appointed to the Board. The Adjunct Director will serve in a non-voting capacity. The Board may establish any other grants or limitations of rights and privileges to the Adjunct Director at its discretion.

Summary of change: allows for participation of members to contribute their experience to the board



Bylaws updates

Number of At-large Directors

7.2.(g)

Three (3) at-large Directors selected by Architect, Associate, and International Associate who are not members of any AIA Chapter within AIA International's domain, in a manner prescribed by the Board. All such Directors shall serve staggered terms of two years each. In the event any such Director is unable or unwilling to serve, the Board shall fill the resulting vacancy for the remainder of the Director's term of office.

Summary of Change:

Increase number of 'At-large' directors from 2 to 3 to better facilitate the provision of core member services to the unassigned members.
