- Opening balance (01 Jan 2022): \$142,076.14
- Closing balance (31 Dec 2022): \$51 936,38
- From the opening balance 54% of resources were utilized in the pending bills of the "Dubai's Conference" (\$77,405.45).
- From the opening balance 7% were for travel expenses executed in 2021 (\$10,237.87)
- The total resources from the opening balance for the year 2022 after paying the expenses executed in 2021 were \$54,433.13
- The total income for the year 2022 was \$87 007,50; minus the total of the real expenses for the year 2022 that were \$83 516,30; resulting a net profit of \$3 491,20 for this period.
- It was a difficult year to collect the payments from our Sponsors.
- A great achievement was done by Administrative Director Genie Khmelnitski and former Secretary Alex Miller. They negotiated additional revenue for the AIA International for the future, starting from the year 2023. This income comes from the AIA's membership income.



Attendance was encouraging from Nigeria, Uganda, Sri Lanka, South Africa and many parts of Zone 2.


