All entries selected by the jury for a Merit or Honor award are also eligible for recognition in this category, with a focus on those demonstrating meaningful, sustainable and integrated design that enhances human health, energy efficiency and stewardship of our diminishing resources.

The AIA International sponsor and co-initiator of SFA is The Dow Chemical Company (Dow). In 2017, Dow was named Official Carbon Partner of the International Olympic Committee (IOC). In this role, Dow used a proven collaboration blueprint to implement carbon mitigation projects beyond the Olympic Games and around the world to challenge current practices. The Inclusive Design Excellence Award (IDEA) honors projects that combine design excellence with universally inclusive design.

All entries selected by the jury for a Merit or Honor award are also eligible for recognition in this category, with a focus on those demonstrating meaningful, inclusive and accessible integrated design that supports all people.

Projects are reviewed for their implementation to go beyond regulations relating to accessibility, incorporate tactile way-finding and signage for the visually impaired, incorporate design solutions to support the hearing impaired, incorporate solutions to support neurodiverse users; and additional elements to ensure community inclusivity and equity.

Additionally, projects are encouraged to share any innovations or certifications achieved. 2023 marks the second year for this critical metric of design excellence. Projects are encouraged to share any innovations or certifications achieved.
