

The Royal Institute of British Architects (RIBA) Chapter in Sri Lanka is organizing an International Conference on Architecture in collaboration with the American Institute of Architects (AIA) and the Italian Embassy of Sri Lanka on the theme: "Architecture: A Lasting Impact" on Saturday the 5th and Sunday the 6th August 2023, at the Oak Room, Cinnamon Grand Hotel, Colombo.

TOURS

Then proceed to Colombo Fort : once the "financial district" of Sri Lanka examining the British Colonial Architecture.

Arrive at the Dutch Hospital, today turned into an up-market shopping mall & restaurants which is believed to have existed since 1681 during the Dutch Rule.

Examine the British Colonial Parliament building of 1921, which is now the President's office & Galleface Green and the British Colonial Galle Face Hotel of 1864, another marvel of the British Colonial period.

Proceed to Lotus Tower of 350m in height for a breath-taking 360 view of the City with a stop at Gangaramaya Buddhist Temple.
